## **NOVEMBER 2022**

### **PASTOR’S MESSAGE**

Years ago, as I was preparing to become the pastor over IBC, I was praying that God would help me to lead well. I didn’t hear an audible voice, but I believe God impressed upon my heart some very powerful words. I was struck with this statement, “I don’t need you to lead, I’ll do that, I just need you to follow me.” Now, in my fourth year as senior, solo pastor of Intermountain Baptist Church, I am even more convinced that my calling isn’t to lead the church, but to follow God and encourage others to do the same.

While things have been going exceptionally well, I am humbled by the realization that God is building His Church, often times despite me, not because of me. I’ve been pondering the early days of King Solomon, as recorded in 2 Chronicles. I have a deep appreciation for Solomon’s prayer to the Lord. A prayer offered in humility as he sat on the throne as king over the people of God. Solomon prayed, “O Lord God, let your word to David my father be now fulfilled, for you have made me king over a people as numerous as the dust of the earth. Give me now wisdom and knowledge to go out and come in before this people, for who can govern this people of yours, which is so great?” (2 Chronicles 1:9-10). Solomon knew that if he was to govern well God would have to supernaturally intervene.

One thing we have been learning in our Sunday School series on the persecuted brothers and sisters that have gone before us, is that when a man or group of men are at the top of a hierarchy, it always ends in disaster. When men desire the authority, power, and honor that are for God alone, they will do very vile and wicked things. Men, apart from God’s supernatural intervention, will always oppress and rule with perversity rather than truth and justice.

As your pastor, I must always be pointing you to HIM. I must always be consumed with His glory, and never my own. I, however, am just a man and I need your help and commitment. I need you to be committed to the Lord, His Word, and His church so that you can help me to stay the course. If we will continue to make God preeminent in the life of IBC, I am confident that God will do more than we can ask or think. If, however, we deviate from His Word and from His will, by the grace of God, we will not succeed. Success in rebellion is one of my greatest fears. But I am confident that God will rebuke us in our sin because we are His children.

As we continue to grow, in numbers and influence, may we also grow in spiritual maturity and love for the Lord. Will you please join the board and me in praying often for the Body-of-Christ at IBC. May we stay true to the Lord. May we cling to Him and desire His will rather than our own, even if His will is that we suffer for The Name. May God be glorified in and through us. May He, like with Solomon, give us great wisdom and knowledge, not to lead people, but to follow God’s lead and encourage others to do the same. Your brother, Pastor Lucas

· 2 Chronicles 6:36-39, “If they sin against you—for there is no one who does not sin—and you are angry with them and give them to an enemy, so that they are carried away captive to a land far or near, 37 yet if they turn their heart in the land to which they have been carried captive, and repent and plead with you in the land of their captivity, saying, ‘We have sinned and have acted perversely and wickedly,’ 38 if they repent with all their heart and with all their soul in the land of their captivity to which they were carried captive, and pray toward their land, which you gave to their fathers, the city that you have chosen and the house that I have built for your name, 39 then hear from heaven your dwelling place their prayer and their pleas, and maintain their cause and forgive your people who have sinned against you.”
